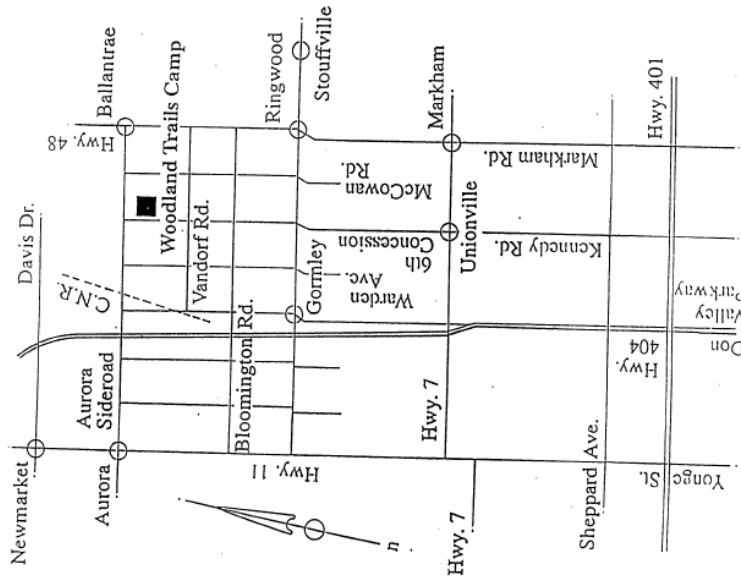
5. Beavers – Welcome Day-Camp 2008
